In the event that a National Federation reduces the number of participating athletes after the final registrations, after paying the fee – each athlete separately, POSA/TC reserves the right to modify the starting order in order to ensure the best possible running of the competition.

Awards ceremonies

The ceremonies at the competition venue will take place as mentioned in the schedule.

Access to the competition area

The competition area is accessible to the members of the various juries, competing athletes and their accredited coaches, to local group leaders, to the auxiliary personnel of the Jury, to the President of the POSA, Medical Commission, the official doctor, the team doctors, medical staff and to persons concerned with the apparatus. A team medical person is permitted to accompany the athletes and coaches during all Competitions.

Scoring and distribution of results

Once the competition has ended, upon request, all delegations will receive by e-mail a complete set of results (**technical sheets only**). The results must be requested via e-mail from the **Head Judge assigned to the judging panel** within **7 days** after the end of the competition.

However, requests must also be sent to the **international federation** within one week after the end of the competition; after this date, it will no longer be possible to obtain them.
(Please refer carefully to the **latest version of the Rules & Regulations**).

Music

To limit the technical problems with the music used for the competitions, the Organizing Committee has decided to only accept the athletes' music in an MP3 format only. All music used during the European Pole Sport Championships 2026 must be submitted online. All Federations requesting a derogation must submit **all documents (including music tracks) in a single package**.

Athletes must send their music by May 30th via email to europeschampposa@gmail.com

Each music file will have to contain the following information:

- The name of the nation (official abbreviation of the country);
- The first and last name of the competitor/s;
- The category;
- (Example: POL_Kowalczyk_Alina_JuniorA_amator_mp3)

In addition, the competitors need to bring their music with them to the venue on the competition day on an USB stick as a backup.

Attention: Incorrectly named music file will receive a warning from the Head Judge (as per the Code of Points).

The list of the categories is available on POSA official website.

Doping control

Any doping is prohibited. A doping control can be done to the athletes at any time, without a pre-warning, in accordance with POSA regulations. Doping controls will be carried out in accordance with the WADA regulations.

Jury Composition

Tie-breaking rule.

In case of a tie at any position at the end of a competition see POSA Aerial Art Rules & Regulations.

In general terms, we remind you that the athlete with the highest score in the artistic section will go up.

Definition of Amateur Athlete.

For the purposes of this definition, reference shall be made to the current POSA Pole Sport Rules & Regulations and the POSA Code of Points.

In order to clearly define and differentiate an Amateur Athlete from a Competitive Athlete in Pole Sport, POSA uses the POSA Code of Points as the governing reference. An Amateur Athlete is defined as an athlete who performs on the pole only elements with a difficulty value of up to 0.5, as specified in the POSA Scoring Code.

Amateur Athletes are permitted to perform a maximum of one (1) element with a difficulty value exceeding 0.5. Any athlete who exceeds this limitation shall be automatically and immediately reclassified and evaluated in the Competitive category.

Prohibited elements include not only those explicitly listed in the POSA Code of Points, but also all variations thereof, as well as any elements whose technical origin is clearly and directly traceable to a coded element.



THE ORGANIZATION OF THE EVENT

Delegations

The following athletes are eligible to participate in the European Pole Sport Championship 2026:

1. Athletes matching the guidelines of the Rules & Regulations (POSA Aerial Art Rules & Regulations)
2. The first 3 classified (Amateurs and Competitive) of the 2025 and/or 2026 National Pole Sport Championships (Depending on when the qualifying competition was organised)
3. All those automatically admitted by the International Federation (Wild Card Athletes).

Registration and accreditation

Each athlete needs to have a competition WHEA/POSA license with approved anti-doping contract 2026.

Athletes must do their registration at latest on 15th of April 2026. Only the Anti-Doping License must be signed by June 31st of January, while the competition registration must be completed by 15th of April 2026.

All documents must be sent by the deadline (30th of May) by email: europenchampposa@gmail.com

The documents to be sent by system are:

- Competitive medical certificate (8 years and older)
- Identity card or passport
- private insurance for foreign athletes. **The organization reserves the right to carry out the necessary checks on the insurance documentation.**
- Athlete registration form by National Federation
- Bank Transfer for entry fee (athlete and coach)

Accreditation allows the identification of all participants and indicates access to specific areas. Access to all areas will be controlled. The **accreditation pass must be worn visibly for the entire duration of the**

event. The accreditation pass is **personal, non-transferable**, and required to access the training and competition halls. The accreditation pass must be **completed with the required information** and presented at the entrance areas **together with an identity document** in order to gain access.

Accreditation will be carried out upon arrival. During accreditation, athletes and/or **Heads of Delegation** will verify the identity of the members of their delegation. In order to obtain accreditation, all members of the delegation must have fulfilled **all required financial obligations** (including insurance).

POSA Directives and Technical Regulations will be strictly applied, particularly with regard to the **number of accredited persons per nation**. Accreditation can be carried out only on the day and within the time slot indicated by the organization. Accreditation may also be completed by the Head of Delegation on behalf of all athletes.

The Head of Delegation or the athlete must present themselves at the accreditation desk with all documents already prepared and any daily allowance in cash, if applicable.

The documents to be presented at the accreditation desk are: a valid identity document and any applicable daily allowance.

Opening ceremony

The Official Opening Ceremony for athletes will be held on June 19th for all Pole Sport categories, in the Competition Hall.

The ceremony will consist of Flags Presentation by nation with the competitors by nation performing a special greeting for the audience. All competitors must wear their national tracksuit.

All delegations must have the National Flag (dimension of 100/200 cm) with them on Opening ceremony.

The opening ceremony is mandatory.

At least five athletes per delegation must be present at the ceremony.

Competition Area

Access to the competition area

- The competition area is accessible to the members of the various juries, competing athletes and their accredited coaches, local group leaders, auxiliary personnel of the Jury, the Medical Commission, and persons concerned with the apparatus.
- Interpreters may not enter the competition area without the permission of the President of Posa.
- The competition area is strictly forbidden to all other persons. Professional photographing and filming of the performances are under written permission from the organizing committee.

Insurance

POSA Technical Regulations stipulate that all participating federations or athletes must assume all costs of the medical insurance of all delegation members (illness and accidents). The Local Organizing Committee has the right to verify the validity of the insurance upon arrival of the delegations (policy insurance, original or copy in english language is better).

Entering the Eroupean Championships without valid medical insurance for all delegation members will be rejected.

Spectator tickets

Spectator tickets can only be purchased on the desk at the hall. Multi-day packages will be available. **The venue has a maximum capacity of 250 people. Once all available seats are sold out, the ticket office will be closed until further availability. Coaches must pay fee by bank account.**

It's mandatory to have at least 1 coach for every 10 athletes for security reasons.

Head of Delegation: free on charge if national federation send an email with name and surname.

Registrations will close on April 15st, 2026. With the exception of Nations granted a special exemption, all athletes are required to complete their registration by the established deadline.

Athletes who fail to formalize their registration by the deadline will be required to pay a €50 late fee starting from April 15st, 2026.

Federations that need to pay in cash are required to ensure that all registered athletes are present. Otherwise, a penalty of €70 for each missing and unjustified athlete will be applied and must be paid directly at the competition venue by the Head of Delegation.

In the event of non-payment of the penalty, all athletes of the non-compliant Federation will be excluded from the competition, with no possibility of any refund.


